

GREATER ROME BOARD OF REALTORS® SCHOLARSHIP

COMPOSITION: This committee shall consist of members of the Education Committee.

Purpose: The Scholarship fund was created to financially assist any active member seeking to achieve any REALTOR® designation or certification. It was created to encourage all Board members to achieve the GAR & NAR designation and certification classes offered, as well as to inform members of existing scholarships available at local Board and State level.

Responsibilities:

1. Keeps members informed of available scholarships at both Local and State Levels.
2. Makes applications readily available to members for both Local and State Levels.
3. Solicits applications for Local Scholarships.
4. Reviews applications and awards scholarships, subject to availability of funds, based on Guidelines and Qualifications.
5. Notifies applicants of decisions.
6. Reviews criteria for disbursement on an annual basis.

Qualifications:

1. REALTOR® applicant must be an active agent in good standing with the Greater Rome Board of REALTORS®.
2. The REALTOR® applicant must be current in all REALTOR® related dues and fees.
3. Applicant must apply for a GAR Scholarship before applying for Local Scholarship.
4. The REALTOR® must submit a written application to the Greater Rome Board of REALTORS® upon completion of course of study. This application will be used as criteria to determine eligibility for GRBR scholarships.
5. The REALTOR® must attend and pass the course applied for and provide documentation of course applied for and of course completion.

Guidelines:

1. The scholarship will apply to all GAR & NAR designations and certifications.
2. Local scholarship fund will supplement scholarship funds awarded by GAR not to exceed full amount of tuition.
4. Scholarships will be awarded upon completion.
5. The applicants will be notified of acceptance or denial.
